COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS

In accordance with FDA standards, RPP samples can be collected using a nasopharyngeal swab. The specimen will be collected as follows:

A sample is collected from the back of your nose and throat (nasopharyngeal swab).

This is done by tilting your head back. A swab is gently inserted through a nostril until resistance is met (about 1 to 2 inches), then rotated several times and withdrawn.

The swab is then placed in sterile Viral Transport Media (VTM). Swabs in VTM remain stable for 30 days at -150°C or below, 4 hours at room temperature, and 3 days when refrigerated (2°C to 8°C).
